## Professional Floristry Program

The Floristry Program is designed to give students with comprehensive information of the floral industry design, management, retail skills and behind the scenes information. The Floristry Program consists of 102 hours of required classes and 24 hours of elective classes.

Students attend two classes each term over three terms. Evening classes are taught by knowledgeable and dedicated industry professionals in the field of floral design.

Topics covered include: floral design history and trends, floral identification, arrangement pricing, customer service and conflict resolution.

Students gain valuable hands-on experience making basic, event and seasonal floral arrangements. Students take home practice arrangements after each class.

Upon successful completion of the program, students are awarded a certificate of completion.

### Program Cost \$1,000

Estimated costs listed include all course work, tuition, fees, and floral supplies.

## Required Program Courses

### Fall Term

#### Basic Floral Lecture/Lab

This course introduces the student to basic floral skills. Learn proper conditioning and care of flowers as well as how to create simple bud vases and corsages, as well as basket and vase arrangements.

#### Basic Floral Design

Reinforce what has been learned in this hands-on practice

### Winter Term

#### Intermediate Floral Lecture/Lab

Students will expand and vary design skills in the intermediate course. Learn floral design history, floral identification skills and practice the art of creating beautiful basket and vase arrangements.

#### Intermediate Floral Design

Expand creativity in this hands-on practice class.

### Spring Term

#### Advanced Floral Lecture/Lab

Students will build on previously learned material to create specific designs, such as wedding, funeral and tropical.

#### Advanced Floral Design

Work in a simulated flower shop. Students receive and fill floral orders with appropriate designs of their own making.
