CPSY 195	Introduction to Addictive Behavior	New course (formerly taught as 199) AAOT listing: EGCD	Course approved as standalone occupational supplementary. Course approved for EGCD AAOT requirement, pending final recommendation from Michael Sámano's sub-committee.

Examples of [Lane’s Career Pathways](#) work and a Portland Community College roadmap in [Accounting](#) were reviewed. All new Career Pathway certificate proposals (less than one year, 12-44 credits) are now required to submit a graphic pathway, showing student entry points, curriculum listings, connections between certificates and degrees and higher education, and employment opportunities at each level.
