

BUS ROUTES:

422–453 and deviations on bus routes that provide service to schools will be canceled when School District 4J school buses are **not** in service or when schools are closed. If 4J schools are open and 4J school buses are operating, LTD may implement detours, depending on road conditions. LTD bus schedules will not be adjusted for 4J late starts or early releases. Route 422 is canceled if Routes 24/33/73 are on snow detour.

Service in Hilly Areas - Snow Zones

When snowy/icy weather hits, LTD evaluates how far the buses can safely travel. This year LTD is introducing Snow Zones 1, 2, 3, and 4, which determine how far the buses can safely travel in the hills. LTD makes every attempt to serve as much of the detoured routes as possible and will place buses back on route as soon as weather permits. As a result, zones may change during the day. Zone 1 service travels as far as the Amazon Station. Zone 2 service travels as far as the Amazon Station, where a transfer will be made to a snow van/bus that continues on to 33rd Avenue. Zone 3 service travels as far as the Amazon Station, where a transfer will be made to a snow van/bus that continues on to 46th Avenue. Zone 4, which includes 46th Avenue and Donald Street and Fox Hollow Street and Donald Street, will not be served when snow detours are in effect. Below are the routes included in the Snow Zones.

Detour routing that has changed from last year is highlighted below.

- **EmX**: If an EmX station is closed, follow directions posted at the station to alternative stops nearby. Buses will use mixed-use traffic lanes to serve alternative stops.
- **25 Amazon**: No service on 20th Avenue.
- **27 Fairmount**: No service along Fairmount Blvd and Walnut Street to 15th Avenue. No service along Riverview Street and Augusta Street.
- **30 Bertelsen**: No service on 11th Avenue between City View Street and Oak Patch Road. No service on Oak Patch Road between 11th and 18th Avenues.
- **33 Jefferson**: A bus/van transfer will occur at 19th Avenue and Jefferson Street. No service will be provided on 28th Avenue between Taylor Street and Chambers Street to 24th Avenue and Fillmore Street.
- **36b West 18th Avenue to Warren**: A bus/van transfer will occur at Bailey Hill Road and 18th Avenue (Churchill Plaza) that will continue on regular routing.
- **76 UO/Westmoreland**: A bus/van transfer will occur at Cleveland Street and 18th Avenue that will continue on regular routing.
- **78 UO/Oak Patch**: No service along Oak Patch Road between 11th and 18th Avenues. Instead the bus will travel along City View Street from 18th Avenue to 11th Avenue.
- **81 LCC/Harris**: If LCC is open, please see [Route 82 LCC/Pearl](#) for service. If LCC is closed, **Route 81 Harris will travel only as far as 30th Avenue and Harris Street. LCC will not be served.**
- **82 LCC/Pearl**: If LCC is open, the bus will not serve Willamette Street or 30th Avenue. Instead the bus will travel along Franklin Blvd and Old Franklin Blvd to arrive at LCC. If LCC is closed, the route will not operate.
- **85 LCC/Springfield**: If LCC is open, this route does not detour. If LCC is closed, the bus will travel only as far as Old Franklin Blvd and Nugget Way.
- **91 McKenzie Bridge**: Depending on weather and road conditions, service may not be provided as far as the McKenzie Bridge Ranger Station. The bus will travel as far as possible before turning around to begin inbound routing, using published timepoints to the extent possible.
- **92 Lowell/LCC (LCC Open)**: If LCC is open, this bus will travel along Franklin Blvd and Old Franklin Blvd to LCC. If LCC is closed, the bus will travel along Franklin Blvd and Old Franklin Blvd to Lowell and will bypass LCC.
- **98 Cottage Grove**: No service along Hwy 99 between I-5 and Main Street. No service on Whiteaker Avenue between Thornton Road and Gateway Street. No service along 10th Avenue, Taylor Street, and 6th Avenue between Main Street and Hwy 99.

When the Snow and Ice Service is put into effect, the LTD website home page, Facebook, and Twitter will be updated with the service changes, and the local news media will be kept informed.
