She will join the meeting shortly after 2p.</p> <p>Discussion:</p> <p>The council reviewed and approved the agenda and meeting minutes of 11/14 and 11/28, 2005. The 12/12, 2005 meeting was canceled.</p> <p>Discussion:</p> <p>The council discussed College Council's concerns with the Student Affairs Council Plan (e.g. Goal 1.1c and Goal 2.1b). The SA Council worked to reword Goal 1.1c to ensure that the goal statement reflects the council's goal to provide students an opportunity to share experiences with each other and not a mechanism to be used for evaluation purposes. Goal 2.1b will be discussed later in the meeting when Barb Delansky is present.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ◆ Nadine wrote a brief statement to be considered by the council as a replacement as follows: "Develop a systematic process that provides students regular and easily available opportunities to share their learning experiences of their instructors with other students." ◆ Sonja will send an e-mail with the statement for further discussion via e-mail and after alterations, the council will vote to approve the new statement at the next meeting. <p>Discussion:</p> <p>The council discussed their need to prioritize the SA Council Plan as previously planned. It was mentioned that the student services directors (the implementers) are using the plan and are developing a list of priorities and implementing goals therein. The council agreed to discuss a process to evaluate the progress being made on the plan goals and a timeline method to measure continuous progress (i.e. one goal or part of a goal each year). The council agreed to: develop a list of the implementers (who is responsible for what), develop an ongoing communication strategy and timelines with implementers for reporting progress to the council.</p>
