Discussion:

- The CCSSE presentation was postponed to the next meeting scheduled for May 22, 2006.
- The council discussed the results of the ASLCC elections. Jeremy shared with the council that the First Time Enrollment Fee was approved by College Council. The \$30 one time fee to credit students will allow excess funds to be allocated to priority items of the Student Affairs Council Plan. After consultation with Student Services Directors and the Student Affairs Council, allocation to priorities will be determined by ASLCC and the Office of Instruction and Student Services and will be approved by the Board. Students will have a say in where the money is going.
- Donna suggested that the council discuss priorities at the meeting in June.
- Kaaren will send e-mail with suggestions for reporting progress to the council.

4. College Council Update

Discussion:

- Jeremy mentioned the discussion at College Council to develop a universal structure for annual reporting to councils.
 - SA Council Plan language not yet approved by College Council.
 - Governance proposals discussed:
 - ◊ ET to reduce council funding by 50% for faculty releases and chairs.
 - ◊ Eliminate all funding except \$10,000 for note taking.
 - ◊ Eliminate all councils except College Council.
- Jeremy mentioned that students want to participate on governance councils. It is a formal way to voice their opinions.
