Mary Parthemer presented an outline of the Foundations of Excellence in the First Year Experience

- It is a two phase project
 - Phase 1 includes a consortium of community colleges to look at dimensions of excellence in which Lane has already agreed to participate
 - Phase 2 allows the phase 1 colleges to apply to participate in assessing how the first year experience is working; strengths and weaknesses and develop a plan for how to improve. There is a 5/16/05 deadline to apply.

- Community programs (BDC, Center for Family Counseling)
- Student run restaurant
- Emergency manual
- Lane Academy: Orientation for special needs students.
- Support for professional development
