- A. **PLANS SAFE AND EFFECTIVE HEALTH CARE** (collects data; understands pathophysiology; identifies appropriate priorities; considers patients' developmental and psychological needs; plans individualized nursing actions and assessments; understands rationales for actions; knows medications and integrates labs; prepares adequately for anticipated nursing procedures)
- B. **IMPLEMENTS SAFE AND EFFECTIVE NURSING CARE.** (completes accurate assessments; safe performance of nursing skills; safely administers medications and IV fluids; demonstrates problem-solving abilities; adapts nursing actions and priorities to meet patients' changing needs; requests supervision appropriately; demonstrates caring and advocacy behaviors)
- C. **PARTICIPATES IN HEALTH TEACHING AND DISCHARGE PLANNING** (develops teaching plans based on the patient's developmental and learning needs; implements teaching plans using appropriate teaching strategies; participates in the evaluation of patient learning and in the modification of the teaching plan; assesses patient discharge needs; initiates appropriate discharge referrals)
- D. **INITIATES AND MAINTAINS EFFECTIVE VERBAL AND WRITTEN COMMUNICATIONS** (appropriate communication with patient, family and health care team; reports pertinent information in a concise and organized manner; charts accurate and complete assessments, interventions, and patient responses to care; charts legibly, uses correct terminology, grammar, and spelling)
- E. **COORDINATES CARE FOR A GROUP OF PATIENTS** (establishes priorities for a group of patients; completes care within reasonable time parameters; collaborates with other health disciplines to provide care; delegates aspects of nursing care to other health care workers; shows accountability for nursing care delegated to others; demonstrates leadership skills in organizing care within the nursing team)
- F. **FUNCTIONS WITHIN THE PROFESSIONAL, ETHICAL AND LEGAL FRAMEWORK OF NURSING** (assumes appropriate level of responsibility; recognizes legal boundaries and ethical considerations; maintains confidentiality of patient information; communicates truthfully; reports concerns regarding quality of care; assumes responsibility for identifying and meeting learning needs; uses constructive criticism and suggestions for improving nursing practice)
