

Today we'll practice using SIRS, a Library database:

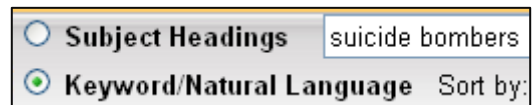
1. Begin at the Library website: <http://lanecc.edu/library/>
2. Then, click on ▶ [Research Databases](#)
3. Click on • [General - all subjects](#)
4. Then scroll down a little bit and click on ▶ [SIRS Knowledge Source](#)

There are two ways to search SIRS:

- A) If you're not sure what topic you want to research, you can click on **More Issues** in the lower right hand corner:



- B) Or you can just search using the search box:



In *SIRS*, you can tell what kind of articles they are by what folder they're in. Click on the **Newspapers** or the **Magazines** folder:
