### **Purpose of project**

### **The project**

1. Size: 12 3/16 inches by 5 1/8 inches.

1. You may use any appropriate media (ink, paint, markers, paper, pencil, digital, etc.)
2. If the project is done by hand, the typography should indicate a real typeface (tracing is permitted).

### **Design**

1. The design and concept should be yours and yours alone. It is not appropriate to solicit advice from instructors or professionals for this project.
2. Your design approach may be illustrative, photographic, typographic, or abstract. All illustrations and photographs, however, must be your own.
3. Your task is to find a fresh way of representing the dollar bill, while still considering functionality.
