

EARLY CHILDHOOD EDUCATION PROGRAM APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

Steps to Complete for Admission to Lane and the ECE Program:

- Admissions to Lane: Please complete all of the required Steps to Enroll: https://www.lanecc.edu/admissions/steps-enroll

Plan Ahead: Mandatory Requirements for ECE 240: Supervised Student Teaching
(One term of ECE 240 is required for an ECE Certificate and three terms for the ECE AAS degree)

- 5. Submit Immunization Recordsat least oneterm before you plan to register for ECE 240.Measles, Mumps, Rubella (MMR) Immunization: You must supply proof of two measles immunizations or have up-to-date vaccination records. If you know you've been vaccinated in Oregon, but can't locate your records, send an email to the Lane Child and Family Center office to ask for help. Include your full name and birthdate: childcareoncampus@lanecc.edu. They can find your immunization records in the Oregon Alert System. If you have been vaccinated outside of Oregon, but do not have access to immunization records, you can go to the LCC Health Clinic on campus and have a Titer blood test showing immunity. You can get MMR immunization shots at the LCC Health Clinic, Building 18 or at Lane County Health, 151 W. 7th, Room 310, Eugene, 541-682-4041. The MMR IMMUNIZATION FEE is \$120.00 each.The Titer blood test costs \$35.00. Insurance usually covers MMR vaccinations but not the Titer blood test.https://www.lanecc.edu/healthclinic/info-for-health-professions-students
