LPN and Paramedic to RN BRIDGE PROGRAM ADVISING

We have placed as many recommendations as possible in this Application Information Packet to help you fill out a successful application to the Bridge Program. It is your responsibility to be aware of program entrance and degree completion requirements and to fill out your application documents correctly.

It is **HIGHLY recommended** that all applicants meet with a Health Professions advisor prior to applying for the program. For the best assistance, be prepared by having a copy of the Bridge Point Petition Sheet filled in (to the best of your ability) along with unofficial copies of all your transcripts. APPLICATION PROCESS & DATES

You are NOT considered an applicant to the program until you meet all application requirements. Please read carefully and follow all directions.

Selection Criteria. Program admission is based on a *point allocation system*. There are no advantages given based on the date/time you submit your application.

Important Dates:

Set your "spam filter" to accept email addresses from @lanecc.edu or your notification may be sent to the spam/junk folder. Do this even if you are currently receiving emails from Lane.

BRIDGE PROGRAM – Once accepted you will complete 2 courses in Summer Term NRS 113A 4 credits & 113B 2 credits. Upon passing Summer term, you will then be fully enrolled in the RN program for Fall Term in 2nd year. 2nd year in the program you will complete the remaining 27 credits. The savings to Bridge students is significant with the lecture and lab core courses and the differential fees for 3 terms.

SUMMER 2026 APPLICATION PROCESS

NEW PROCESS: The application will be created in Target X a system the College has adopted for applications. Here is the link to the Bridge application. [Summer 2026 LPN & Paramedic to RN Bridge Application](#)

Please create an application with a NON LCC Email, even if you are a current student. Once you have started your application, you will choose Special Admissions Programs and choose LPN & Paramedic to RN Bridge.

All supporting documents will be uploaded into the application portal except for your Official Transcripts. You will be able to send your Reference Form directly from the portal to your LPN or Paramedic Faculty or an LPN or Paramedic position supervisor. Your Point Petition Sheet will need to be filled out completely and saved as a fillable PDF. Make sure when you upload it to your Target X application that it is still fillable. We recommend the app AdobeScan to be used to create PDF's for all documents other than the Point Petition Sheet. Be sure to name each file you are uploading with your Last Name, First Name and the name of the document, (i.e. SmithJohnBridge26PointSheet with no spaces.) Please make sure EVERY document you upload is named in this type of format.

Admission to Lane. If you are not currently a Lane credit student, complete a [new student or retuning student application](#). Choose your start term as Summer 2025 and obtain a student L number. You will not be able to submit your application without an L#.

Oregon LPN or Paramedic License (if completed.) For the LPN license, go to the [OSBN website](#) Enter your Name and search, choose View Report and download by license and choose your LPN License for verification of your unencumbered Oregon LPN License. For the **Paramedic** License, go to the [Oregon Health Authority website](#) scroll to bottom, choose Personnel and enter your name or license #. Upload a PDF copy into the Target X portal under Licenses. If you do not have your license yet, you may still apply but must be licensed no later than the end of Summer term in order to continue to Fall term. Please enter your test date if you have it scheduled.

LPN or Paramedic Work or Faculty Reference (required.) This year you will create your application account and there will be a place for you to send the Reference form directly from the application portal. Please have the name and email address ready for the person you are sending it to and do that as early as possible so they have time to complete it before the application deadline. This is REQUIRED and must be received by 11:59pm on the close date or your application will not be able to be submitted. You can see when they have completed it and you can also send reminders from the portal.

POINT PETITION SHEET DIRECTIONS

Please review the details of each requirement and make sure you have filled out the form completely and correctly. Please upload any required documentation as directed. Please note: the Nursing Program and HP Application Center will not correct any errors on your forms. We highly recommend emailing your Point Petition Sheet to hpadvising@lanecc.edu to be reviewed by an academic advisor before submitting.

All courses must have a letter grade of C or higher (C- or lower not accepted.) All A&B grades are now worth equal points. The Math requirement can also have a Pass grade but it will not be eligible for quality points and cannot be used for degree completion. BI 233 cannot be expired and must be taken Fall 2019 or later.

Courses may be repeated, and the most recent unexpired grade **must** be used. Courses from **non-accredited** colleges will **not** be considered in the evaluation of your application, nor can they be considered toward any degree requirement. Meet with a [Health Professions advisor](#) or email HPAdvising@lanecc.edu if you have any questions. Please provide the state and name of institution in your correspondence with them (e.g., Pioneer Pacific does not meet Northwest Commission of Colleges and Universities accreditation criteria and course work cannot be used.)

Students may also use qualifying exam scores in many college subjects through the [Advanced Placement \(AP\), College-Level Examination Program \(CLEP\), and International Baccalaureate \(IB\)](#) programs to receive credit in both general areas and various other specific subject areas. Lane grants credits for Military Educational Experience upon review of the recommendations made by the American Council on Education (ACE). More information available [here](#).

Courses will only be considered with **official transcripts on file** with LCC Enrollment Services by the application deadline.

On the Point Petition Sheet, please enter the number 0 in any number box and N/A in any data box you are not using (other than checkboxes) to let us know that you are purposely leaving that space blank.

Section 1A - Required to Apply Courses

Anatomy & Physiology – BI 231 (4 credits): BI 231 graded C or higher (C- not accepted) is required to be completed prior to applying to the program. BI 112 is a prerequisite to BI 231 at LCC. If any of these courses were not taken at Lane, use the [Lane Transfer Tool](#). If a course you are using is not listed on the Transfer Tool, then contact the Degree Evaluators at DegreeEvaluators@lanecc.edu. Advisors can also assist with this process, but this MUST be done PRIOR to submitting your application. If your BI 231 course is more than 7 years old – ONLY BI 233 needs to be repeated Fall term 2019 or later. You may not apply with only expired A&P courses.

Math: Choice of MTH 95 or higher, with letter grade of C or higher (C- not accepted) for points **OR** you can submit qualified documentation of math proficiency from the below options, these will meet **application requirements only** and **do not** count towards credits required to apply **OR** for points. Please see the notes for non-eligible degree options.

- MTH 95 or higher for Pass Grade
- Lane Credit by Exam for MTH 95 or higher (not eligible for degree completion)

Section 2A - Required by end of Summer Term Courses

Anatomy & Physiology – BI 232 & 233 (8 credits): BI 232 and BI 233 graded C or higher (C- not accepted) are required to be completed prior to starting the 2nd year of the RN program. If either of these courses were not taken at Lane, use the [Lane Transfer Tool](#). If a course you are using is not listed on the Transfer Tool, then contact the Degree Evaluators at DegreeEvaluators@lanecc.edu. Advisors can also assist with this process, but this MUST be done PRIOR to submitting your application. BI 233 must have been completed within 7 years prior to starting the Bridge Program (taken Fall term 2019 or later).

Reminder: If your A&P courses are more than 7 years old – ONLY BI 233 needs to be repeated Fall term 2019 or later. You may not apply with only expired A&P courses. **EXCEPTION:** If you have been working in the field as an LPN or a Paramedic for a period of time Email HPApplicationCenter@lanecc.edu and the expired A&P courses **may** be waived.

WR 121z AND WR 122z or WR227z (8 credits):

Applicants must have WR 121z and either WR 122z or WR 227z completed by Fall term. A full **8 credits of Writing is required by Fall Entry**. If 121 and/or 122/227 were taken for 3 credits, students must take a 3rd writing class above WR121 **prior to Fall Entry**. Grades of C or higher (C- not accepted.)

Applicants who have earned a bachelor's degree from a U.S. regionally accredited institution may waive this requirement but **need** to use **approved** electives in their place that meet the Section 3 elective requirements to meet the 25-credit minimum to apply. An official transcript must be on file with proof of bachelor's degree to use electives or waive the 8-credit writing requirement for the AAS degree. IB does not meet the requirement to use approved electives in place of WR121z or WR 122z.

PSY 215 Lifespan Developmental Psychology: You must have a course that is equivalent to LCC's PSY 215. Graded C or higher (C- not accepted.)

Approved Electives: (IF needed to reach min. 25 credits to apply)

- You can use Approved Electives to reach the **Minimum of 25 and Maximum of 29 total qualified quarter credits** to apply to the program. However, if you have all 7 prerequisite courses completed, NO electives are needed.
- Electives must be from a category listed in the [2025-2026 Approved Electives for Nursing AAS](#) – choose Program Requirements and scroll down to Electives. **IF** the transfer course does not directly match one of our subject codes (i.e. AH, SOC, CJA, PSY, etc.) you must have the course evaluated by the Degree Evaluators and the course must be listed on the transfer tool as equivalent to one of the accepted subjects. Please work with an advising team member to have your course(s) evaluated PRIOR to submitting your application.
- Career/Technical Courses **and** HO/HP/HE/PE courses are not allowed.

- No more than two elective courses in one subject can be listed in Section 1 (i.e., BI 112, BI 201 and BI 202, – BI 202 could not be listed and you must choose a course with a different subject for the 3rd elective.)
- Electives must be higher than the required pre-requisite courses for writing and math (i.e., WR115 is below WR121.)

Failure to complete the Fall required courses with a C or higher with a continuing prerequisite GPA of 3.00 or higher by the end of Summer term in the year of acceptance will result in forfeiture of acceptance into the program.

TOTAL CREDITS, GPA & POINTS: The Quarter Credits Taken and GPA Points columns will auto calculate. The GPA Credits column will NOT automatically calculate, please calculate this column yourself once all items in Sections 1A, 2A & 3A have been entered. Be sure to ONLY count the GPA credits for the courses you have completed by the time you are submitting your application. The GPA can be calculated by dividing the Total GPA Points (far right column) by the GPA Credits (column you add, directly next to GPA points.) (Note: Do not count the Sample line credits.)

Section 4 – GPA and Additional Application Points

Prerequisite GPA Points:

0-5 points

Prerequisite GPA (Minimum PQ GPA of 3.00 to apply and maintained for Fall entry) GPA pulled from Section 1A-1C used courses ONLY. The GPA points column divided by total # of GPA Credits and round to hundredths. C- and below not considered and +/- will not be calculated. (Be sure to calculate the GPA Credits column and do not count anything you do not have completed, and do not count the sample line.) Choose from the GPA ranges below to find your points to add to the Point Petition Sheet.

4.00 – 3.50 = **5 points**

3.49 - 3.33 = **3 points**

3.32 - 3.00 = **0 points**

Prerequisites in Sections 1 & 2 Completed:

5 points

All prerequisites listed in Sections 1 & 2 above completed and transcribed by application submission to receive points

Medical Terminology Course: (HP/HO 100)

3 points

HP/HO 100 Medical Terminology (or equivalent) minimum of 2 credits with grade of C- or higher (Pass grades will only be accepted on HP 100 if completed by Fall 2018.) You must also fill in ALL of the requested information on the Point Petition Sheet to qualify for points.

Technical Writing Course (WR 227 or WR 227z)

3 points

WR 227 or WR 227z (or equivalent) with grade of C- or higher. You must also fill in ALL of the requested information on the Point Petition Sheet to qualify for points.

Statistics (MTH 243z or STAT 243z)

3 points

MTH 243z or STAT 243z (or equivalent) with grade of C- or higher. You must also fill in ALL of the requested information on the Point Petition Sheet to qualify for points.

Nutrition: (FN 225)

3 points

FN 225 (or equivalent) with grade of C- or higher. You must also fill in ALL of the requested information on the Point Petition Sheet to qualify for points.

Microbiology: (BI 234)

3 points

BI 234 (or equivalent) with grade of C- or higher and dated within the last 7 years (Fall term 2019 or later.) You must also fill in ALL of the requested information on the Point Petition Sheet to qualify for points.

Lane County Resident:

3 points

Residency will be assessed by the street address of the applicant **in myLane**. Make sure your address is up to date in myLane at least 90 days prior to applying. No PO Boxes. See [Residency rules](#) for Lane Community College.

Military Service:**3 points**

You must submit a copy of your current ID card as documentation in active status, can be AD, Reserve, NG, or submit a DD-214 showing an Honorable Discharge. There is no required field of training or education needed. You must also fill in all of the requested information on the Point Petition Sheet to qualify for points.

Anatomy & Physiology – No Repeat (BI 231, BI 232 & BI 233) courses:**3 points**

If you have **completed** the entire series, prior to applying with a C or better (C- not accepted) and have not repeated any of the A&P 1, 2 or 3 courses **or** have **only** repeated A&P 3 due to the 7-year expiration, and have a current you will qualify for full points. Withdrawals (W) or (*) is also accepted.

Lane Community College Credits:**4-6 points**

Nursing prerequisite credits taken at LCC **and** listed in Sections 1 & 2

Foreign Language Competency: (C- or higher ONLY accepted for language fluency points. D and below not accepted.)

Native Speaker with proof of “Advanced” or higher language proficiency

[OPI, OPIc and LPT assessments](#) are acceptable proficiency exams administered from Language Testing International. Please note there are costs associated with any of the above exams. Documentation should be sent to Lane Community College, Enrollment Services, 4000 E. 30th Avenue, Eugene OR 97405 **NOT** the HPApplicationCenter. Be sure the results will arrive prior to the deadline.

CLEP Testing Information

The College Board's College-Level Examination Program (CLEP) with a 63+ or higher. These are a collection of nationally standardized examinations, covering 33 different subject areas. [Lane CLEP Credit Information](#). Please note there are costs associated with any of the above exams. For a testing site near you, please visit <https://clep.collegeboard.org/> Have proficiency documentation sent to Lane Community College, Enrollment Services, 4000 E. 30th Avenue, Eugene OR 97405 or upload the results with your online Bridge application. All documents must be received by the application deadline.

College or HS Foreign Language: All transcripts with foreign language listed must be received by the application deadline in order to receive points. (see below)

3 terms or 2 semesters of same language, college level (transcripted)

4 points

Official college transcript must be on file to receive points.

Fill out all of the language information on the Point Petition Sheet in order to receive points.

2 years (progression) same language, high school

1 point

HS transcript must be uploaded in Target X. (HS transcript showing completion of Spanish 1, Spanish 2, etc. will be accepted.)

Please name the PDF file with your Last Name, First Name and HS Transcript – Spanish (etc.) prior to uploading. Fill out the language fields on the Point Petition Sheet in order to receive points.

LPN or Paramedic Supervisor or LPN or Paramedic Faculty Reference Form: (Required to apply)

Please have the contact information for an LPN or Paramedic Supervisor that has supervised you in that role or an LPN or Paramedic faculty that has overseen you in clinicals. You will then send them a reference form directly from your online portal that they will fill out and return. There will be a place for you to see when the reference has completed the documentation, send them reminders or cancel and send to another reference. The completion of this step is required for your application to be complete. Please watch for these results PRIOR to the deadline.

The results of the reference are not shared with the applicant. Only the HPApplicationCenter. We will then add the points directly to your point petition sheet.

Total Application Points:

Please be sure your application packet is automatically adding all of the points. If there is an issue, please Email HPApplicationCenter@lanecc.edu and be sure to submit your application with all required fields and documents by midnight on the day of the deadline. The only document required to remain fillable is the Point Petition Sheet. Any other documentation can be a static PDF.

Notes to Application Center:

If you have any additional information that you feel is relevant to any of the items listed on the Point Petition Sheets or supporting documentation, please put the information in this section. This is a good place to enter courses you have in process as well.

Current, unencumbered Oregon LPN or Paramedic License: (Required by end of Summer Term)

If you have already an LPN or Paramedic license, please upload a copy of your license in your online application portal when you apply. If you are not yet licensed, you will enter the date of your expected licensing test into the portal. You must have a license no later than the end of Summer Term in order to start in the 2nd year of the RN program.
