



## **Consideration of Modified Attendance/Assignment Due Dates Student Agreement**

Center for Accessible Resources (CAR)

All students using the consideration of modified attendance and assignment due dates accommodation are responsible for understanding the following:

- Students are encouraged to complete this process as early as possible because retroactive accommodations will not be provided. For more information on accommodation request timelines visit:

- This accommodation is not a blanket reason to miss class or to turn in assignments late.
- Instructors may give additional assignments to make up for absences.
- Students with this accommodation are still required to complete all course work within the term.
  - Receiving this accommodation does not mean the student is entitled to an incomplete for the course.
- Faculty are not obligated to re-teach material missed due to absences or late assignments.
- Being absent or handing in late assignments for reasons that are not related to the effects of a disability are not included as a part of this accommodation. Students are responsible for following the faculty member's syllabus regarding absences and late assignments that are due to non-disability related issues.
  - Reasons unrelated to disability include but are not limited to: family matters, child/elder care, travel, and most routine medical/dental appointments.
- If the student does not follow the modification agreement or does not meet other course expectations, the instructor has all grading options available to them. (This includes assigning a non-passing grade, granting an incomplete, and requesting students to consult with their academic advisor for the impact of grading options on their academic standing.)

- **International students need to consult with the International Department before making any grade option changes.**
- This accommodation may not be allowed for the course if modification of attendance or assignment due date policies would result in a fundamental alteration of the curriculum.
- If it has been determined that this accommodation would threaten the integrity of the course, discussions will take place between the student, the instructor, and the student's CAR Accommodation Specialist so that the student can then make an informed decision regarding alternatives.
- Students are required to meet with their CAR Accommodation Specialist once each term to review their use of this accommodation and to maintain eligibility.
