WHAT

Money for school: reimbursement up to **\$4,500.00**, with possible support funds
Career Advisor to help you find work in your training field

WHO

Lane County, Oregon residents who will finish training within one year of scholarship award and who plan to go directly to work in their training field upon training completion

WHY

To invest public U.S. Department of Labor funds in individuals whose training will soon result in high-demand, living-wage occupations needed in the local labor market, enhancing the productivity and competitiveness of the nation as a whole

WHEN

You may request a WIOA scholarship application at any time

WHERE & HOW

Step 1 - Create/update WorkSource Oregon profile as a "Job Seeker" at www.imatchskills.org

Step 2 - Visit WorkSource Lane, 2510 Oakmont Way, Eugene (no appointment needed):

- Complete customer registration / show ID
- Schedule the National Career Readiness Certificate (NCRC)
- Fill out a yellow card to request a scholarship application

Step 3 – Earn the National Career Readiness Certificate (prior sign-up required)

Step 4 - (optional) Call 541-686-7985 for an appointment for one-on-one assistance

Step 5 - Complete the WIOA Scholarship application and submit by deadline
