Developmental Credit Limit

Only complete this process if you have a Developmental Credit Limit hold on your Financial Aid account. This letter would have been mailed to you, but is available online for your convenience.

You are receiving this notice because it appears you may exceed the developmental credit limit. Per federal regulations, a maximum of 45 attempted developmental credits are eligible to be funded by financial aid. This is a lifetime limit and applies to your enrollment at all colleges. There is no appeal process to extend past this limit. This does not mean you cannot take developmental courses, but it does mean that our office will not count your enrollment in developmental credits when determining your awards once you reach the 45 credit limit.

Developmental courses currently being offered at Lane include all courses numbered 001-099 (unless the course is published as required for your current program [such as a lower math]); and ENG 116.

We have placed <u>a hold on your financial aid disbursements</u> until you complete this form and it has been reviewed by our office. A written response will be mailed within 4 weeks and may include additional conditions and/or recommendations.

Complete the following steps and submit to Financial Aid for review:

STEP 1 Schedule placement exams (if applicable) - If you have not finished your math requirement and have not taken a math course or placement exam in the past year, you must complete new placement exam before completing the next steps. The reading and writing placement exams do not expire.

coursework (courses that apply to your program), above and beyond your developmental credits.
