Member suggested to invite other staff members not only council members, it should be an opportunity to recruit for the councils.</p>
<p>Governance web pages</p>	<p><i>Member pages</i> Changes have been done to the governance web page by webmaster without consultation with College Council. Some of the changes are related to ADA regulations. And the other changes had to do with note takers updating the members of their councils. Elizabeth Andrade will work with webmasters on a new format that has everything in one page. College Council decided to continue with current process that only Elizabeth Andrade will be the person updating the membership page.</p>
