An institutional learning plan is intended to galvanize the collective intelligence, efforts, and resources of the college community toward achieving an exemplary learning environment. The learning plan defines a set of long-term learning goals while building coherency among institutional core themes, strategic planning, and student experiences and outcomes across all areas of Lane Community College. The learning plan will include steps for measuring and assessing progress. The long-range learning plan shall be reviewed and revised as scheduled in the plan to assure currency, relevancy, and agility, allowing Lane to balance progress toward institutional learning goals with adaptability to challenges and opportunities. In order to reflect Lane's mission and core values accurately and holistically, the learning plan's development, implementation, and review shall include the participation of college faculty, administrators, students, and staff.
