Session	• Strategies seemed more like objectives so that change will be made
	• Information literacy called out when other learning outcomes were not called out individually
	• Used a lot of different words to say the same thing
	• The language is abstract and is challenging for certain audiences (student for example). It might be good to explicitly say who the primary and secondary audience is for the Learning Plan. Maybe each plan needs to have an inspiring and short tag line that make it more accessible.
	 Departments & divisions should be integrated into the development of the plan to reflect the collective knowledge of the campus. Ask departments/division how they improves teaching and learning and then incorporate/reflect those ideas in the plan so it reflects the work being done in the diverse areas.
	• There are challenges around there being so many plans and how the plans get implemented at the department level. The governance system creates policies/high level institutional goals and implementation happens at the department level planning process and there needs to be alignment as we are moving from the policy to the implementation level. This includes the 5 year program review process.
	 Applying the Equity Lens is a little premature because the lens is still in the early developmental phase.
	 Addressing the issues that are still outstanding will be the early work to be done by the Learning
	Council next year and the learning plan will not be rolled out until later in the next year
	 Could push out the principles of excellence in teaching and learning in the learning plan as part
	of the department planning process to start the connection to be made
	 In the fall, the focus could be to provide support to departments/division so they can create
	alignment/connection between the department planning process and the learning plan with a
	focus on excellence in teaching and learning. Learn from what is being done at the
	department/division level, hold on to ideas that there are not resources for and connect people to resources that are available.
