Websites that aren't in the firewall's catalog may be blocked until that site's reputation is known/calculated. Knowbe4 provides modules that can teach people how to avoid phishing and is able to test users with fake phishing. Bill did not have a cost for this service. He wanted to let the group know about this service and see what thoughts were. Ian said some instructors' websites get blocked by the firewall and that this could be a burden on teaching.
