 - Bill asked, does the Archive web site need to be online? Would it be better suited for the D.A.M?

- Survey Development update (Carl & Ian)
 - Review of updated survey
 - No new updates it is still in process
 - Do annual IRAP and IT satisfaction surveys: ask for strengths and opportunities for improvement: What is working, what is not working?

- **Achieving the Dream coaches came to visit and recommended that we do an IRAP & IT satisfaction survey each year to ask for strengths and opportunities for improvement.
- There is a COPPS policy that we sent the survey to IRAP before sending it out.
- COPPS Policy on authorization to conduct surveys
- Student Email Directory Update
 - Bill shared that there is some talk about creating a data governance group.
 - They would think about FERPA, Unconscious Bias and what information should be shared and with whom.
 - They would set up some guidelines for data and information
 - Ian asked if this group would be outside of the governance system.
 - Yes, a separate committee and they will be given some authority to make decisions on how we share data at Lane. Right now there is no much confusion what can or cannot be shared.
 - How we use messaging is also a concern and will be looked at.
 - Kyle suggested that we keep messaging separate from the data governance group. There is different information needed by each different group. Data governance people should be conservative about who they grant access to, where the communication group would want to be more aggressive on the information that is sent out.

- New Business
 - College ID Card Update?
 - The committee met last week and another tomorrow.
 - There are approximately 23 items of different uses.
 - We would not integrate the Higher One Card FA balance into this new ID Card.
 - We are looking at doing an RFP (request for funding)
 - Hoping to have a prototype and testing by Summer term and roll out Fall term.
 - College-wide Email System (employee)

- Concerns about changing Email Systems and should there be a subcommittee formed?
- Is this the right group to continue this conversation?
- We did a survey and there was a majority in every class of employee who wanted to change.
- Roger added that this conversation needs to include Thad,
 Denise and Ed in order to end the cycle of "it works or it doesn't work" or it's a training issue
- The survey indicated that there wasn't really a majority, it was split right down the middle. But the MAC client doesn't work as well. But there was a majority that want to switch to Gmail and Calendar.
- It would also increase the use of G-suite. And the use of some of the add-on's
- Should we survey again? Or use a focus group.
- Carl suggest that the decision be made by the people of expertise and not by what's popular.
- Would there be any monetary value in changing? This would need to be investigated.
- There is no cost for the product but there is a cost for the implementation.
- Kyle suggested that a subcommittee to look into these questions.
- Summer would be a good time to transition. How quickly can it be changed over? The training would be the hardest part.
- It was recommended that Kerry Levett and Brett Rowlet be the executive sponsors.
- Kyle presented a motion to form a subcommittee that includes outside members including faculty, classified but no Tech Council members. They will prepare a cost benefit analysis and a potential transition plan and make a firm recommendation to leave GroupWise and move to Gmail. Motion was 2nd by Tony and approved unanimously.
